

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

IMMEDIATE NEEDS

- * **Individual sponsorships** to high school for deserving students leaving 8th grade who didn't win the one annual scholarship. This would be your student, boy or girl, and you would communicate directly with him or her. Cost: \$850 per year, with a 4-year commitment required
- **Tables and benches** for the Class 1 children. Cost: \$1060 for 10 tables and 20 benches
- * **More laptops.** In order for each Class 7 and 8 student to have individual access, we need 62 more laptops. Cost: about \$300 each
- * **Ramps** alongside stairs for physically challenged students, small kids, and the elderly. Cost: \$5850

CONTINUING NEEDS

- * **Two teachers** so we can continue to separate Class 7 and 8 boys from girls. Cost: \$1450 per teacher per school year (yes, that's per year, not per month!)
- * **Lucy Nyawira Memorial Scholarship** for top student graduating each year from 8th grade. Cost: About \$4250 per year to keep five students in residence high school concurrently
- * **Sanitary napkins** for girls in order to facilitate their staying in school and attending classes. Cost: \$848 per year
- * **Teachers' annual field trip to high-performing school.** Cost: \$250
- * **Abdul Hamid Wildlife Day.** Hires a school bus for the annual outing to Sweetwaters for the top four and most improved in Classes 4 through 8. Cost: \$600

ABOUT YOUR DONATION

Ngandu's Angels is operated by a Board of Directors consisting of Michele Burgess and her three sisters. Directors are unpaid volunteers, and we have no paid staff. In Focus with Michele Burgess pays all expenses other than bank and government fees, so that virtually 99.9% of your donation goes to improving the facilities, services, and education at Ngandu School, or for providing high school scholarships.
